

Table 2. Fluid Replacement Therapy in the Second Twenty-four Hours

Solutions	Formula	Example
Colloid	$\frac{1}{2}$ to $\frac{3}{4}$ of the above amount	for the same patient: $\frac{1}{2} \times 1,050 \text{ cc.} = 525 \text{ cc.}$
Electrolyte	$\frac{1}{2}$ to $\frac{3}{4}$ of the above amount	for the same patient: $\frac{1}{2} \times 3,500 \text{ cc.} = 1,750 \text{ cc.}$
Glucose in water or Lactated Ringer's	use a fixed amount, <i>i. e.</i> , 2,000 cc.	total in example — 4,275 cc.
