## I - TACTICAL SITUATION

1. ENEMY FRONT LINES - No Change.

2. V CORPS OPERATIONS

V Corps Front. Enemy activity was confined mainly to arty fire, moderate in the southern and central sectors and very light in the northern sector. Small enemy foot and vehicle movements were observed or head all along the front but no undue significance is placed on these.

3. OTHER FRONTS

Little enemy activity was reported in the remainder of the First and Third Army sectors. The enemy resisted strongly but was pushed west several thousand yds at the mouth of the BASTOGNE salient and was also forced to give a like amount of ground on a wide front south of WILTZ (P 71 54). It is believed that there is an enemy concentration north of BASTOGNE. XVIII Corps reported that the enemy had drawn back from the immediate front to selected positions in rear. One strong enemy combat patrol attempted to cross the ROER River in rubber boats at (F 11 44) but was repulsed.

# 4. OPERATIONS OF COMPONENT ELEMENTS

(1) Air. One enemy plane was reported over the area at 1905 hrs.

- (2) Armor. Tow tanks were observed at (K 925 015) and (K 915 017), of which one was destroyed. Tracked vehicles were heard on the southern front during the hrs of darkness. One SP gun was observed at (K 979 023) during the afternoon.
- (3) Artillery. Enemy arty fire decreased sharply to 75% of that of the previous period. Eighty shellings were reported to Corps arty, averaging 19 rds each, and are believed to represent 50% of the actual fire. Calibers were predominantly light with some 170-mm fire reported. Fire was largely on front line units and was greatest in the wirtzfeld area.

5. MISCELLANEOUS

(1) A PW stated that a drive toward LIEGE from the (P 37 88) - (P 52 90) area would be launched during the first period of bad weather. This drive would be spearheaded by 1st and 12th SS Pz Divs and followed up by 2d, 9th, 10th, 17th SS Divs, CROSSDEUTSCHLAND Brigade and Kg. DECRELLE. This is considered as logical although no evidence of the presence of the 17th SS Pz Gren Div or of Kg. DECRELLE in this area are known.

(2) According to higher headquarters, Ninth Army no longer believes there is an enemy build up on its front. Also reported from this sector: the enemy of his own accord has blown a bridge over the ROFR at (F 09 36); the enemy is reported insensitive to our patrols east of the ROER River; and movement east of the river has been predominently to the south.
