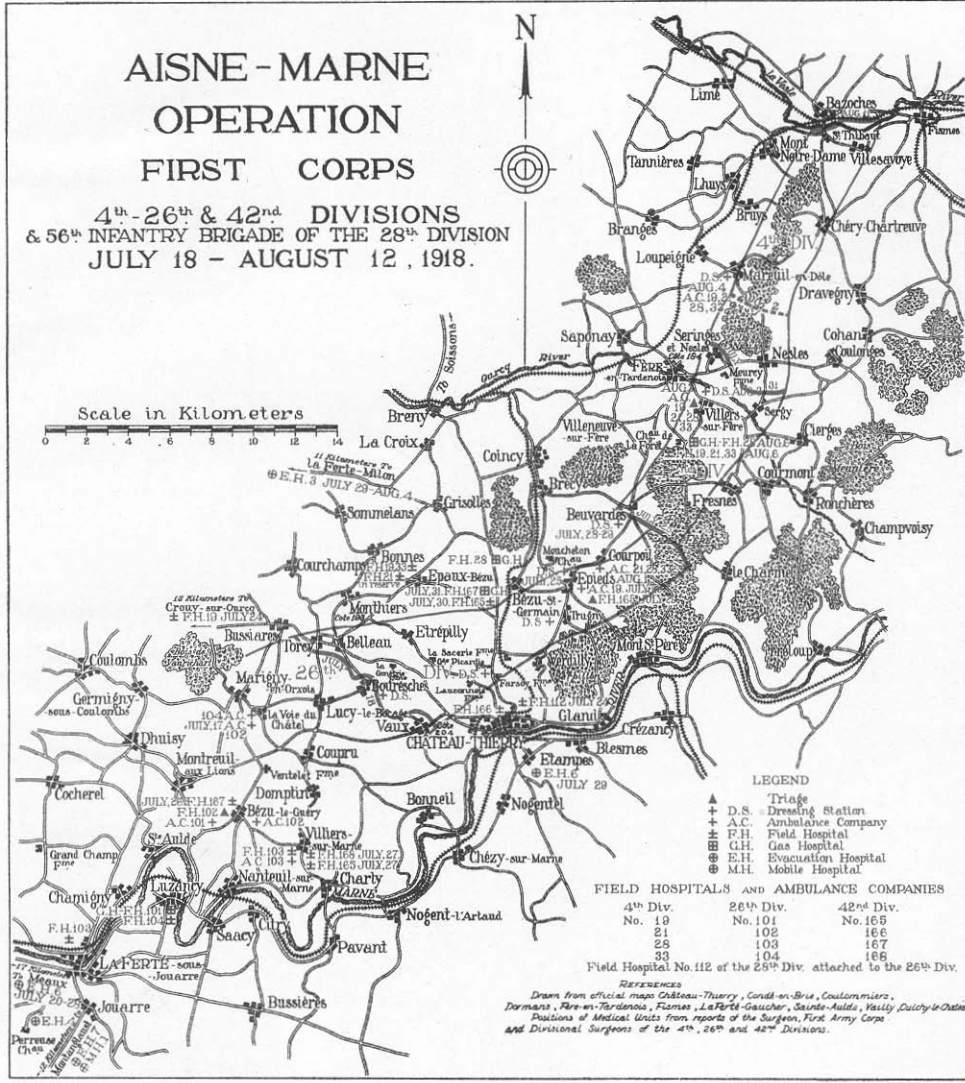


# AISNE - MARNE OPERATION FIRST CORPS
