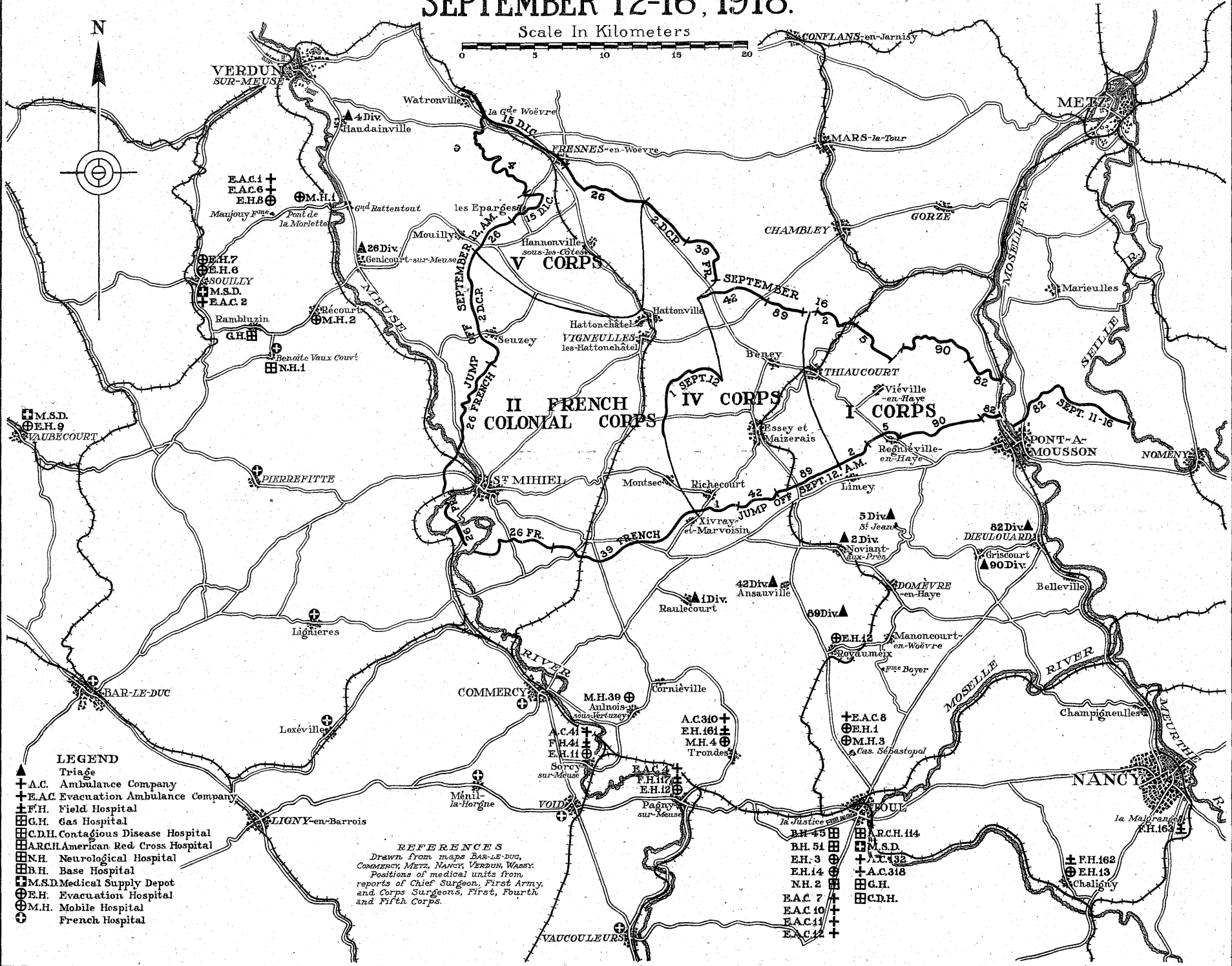


ST. MIHIEL OPERATION SEPTEMBER 12-16, 1918.
