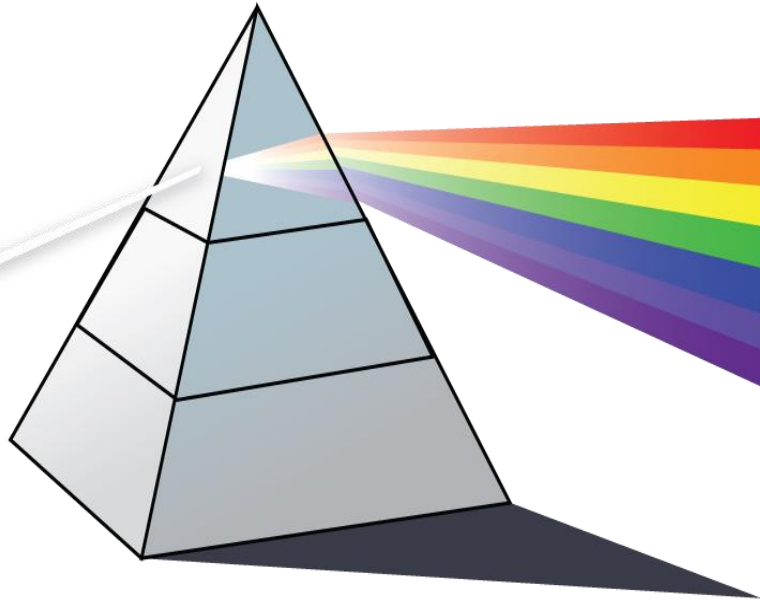
**The AMEDD Captains Career Course (CCC)** provides officers with instruction in tactical, technical and leader knowledge and skills required to lead company-size units and serve on clinic, hospital, battalion, and brigade staffs. The course emphasizes the development of leader competencies while integrating operational experiences of the students with quality institutional training. It facilitates life-long learning through an emphasis on self-development. The curriculum includes common core subjects, corps-specific tactical and technical instruction, and branch-immaterial staff officer training.

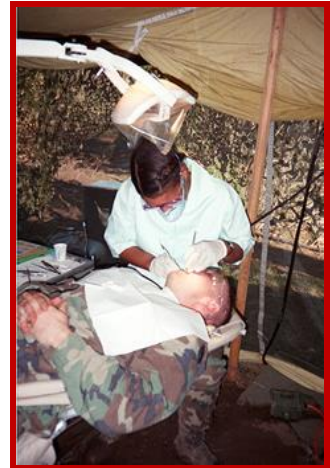
