eon L. Ban Autreve, the fourth Sergeant Major of the Army, was sworn in on July 1, 1973, and served until his term ender n June of 1975. He was born in Eeklo, Belgium, on Jan. 29, 1920. SMA Van Autreve saw increasing the standards of the Army's noncommissioned officer corps as his highest priority. As part of he rejuvenation of the NCO Corps Ian Autreve gave NCOs more voice in command decisions, reduced the Army's reliance on Soldiers' councils, increase professional standards for NCOs developed the Noncommissioned Officer Education System, and encouraged NCOs to have the moral courage to police heir own ranks. For these reasons we have named a hall at the AMEDD NCO Academy in honor of SMA Van Autreve.
